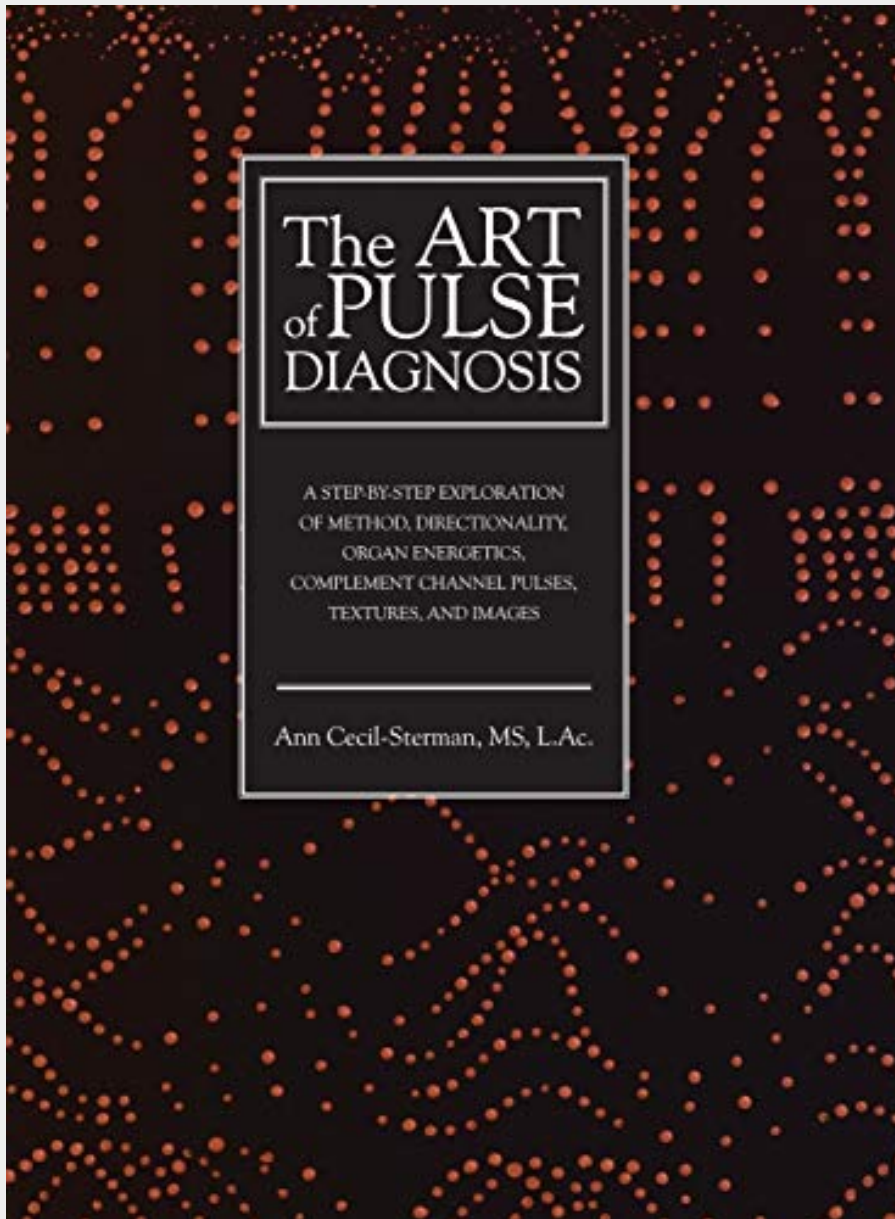

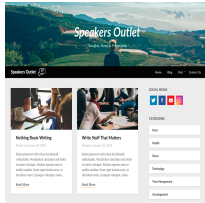

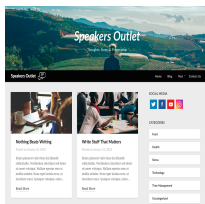

Amazing manual for any student or practitioner of Chinese Medicine who doesn't feel confident in pulse diagnosis .

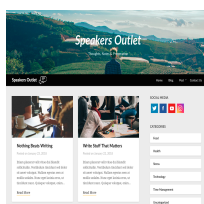

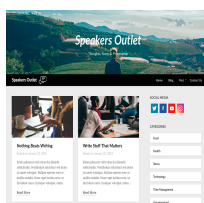
