The story that inspired the project, *The Farmer's Clever Daughter*, is one of the few folk tales where a girl uses her wits and intelligence alone to solve her problems, rather than rely on magical intervention, and is included in this volume. In keeping with the original tales, the gory violent bits are not hidden or changed, so it's not the best for young children. The best story is *The Little Shroud*, an almost wordless tale on childhood death and parental grief. Also included is *The Old Man His Grandson*, an smartly educational story on elder abuse and karma. There's something for everyone and should be read by all.
